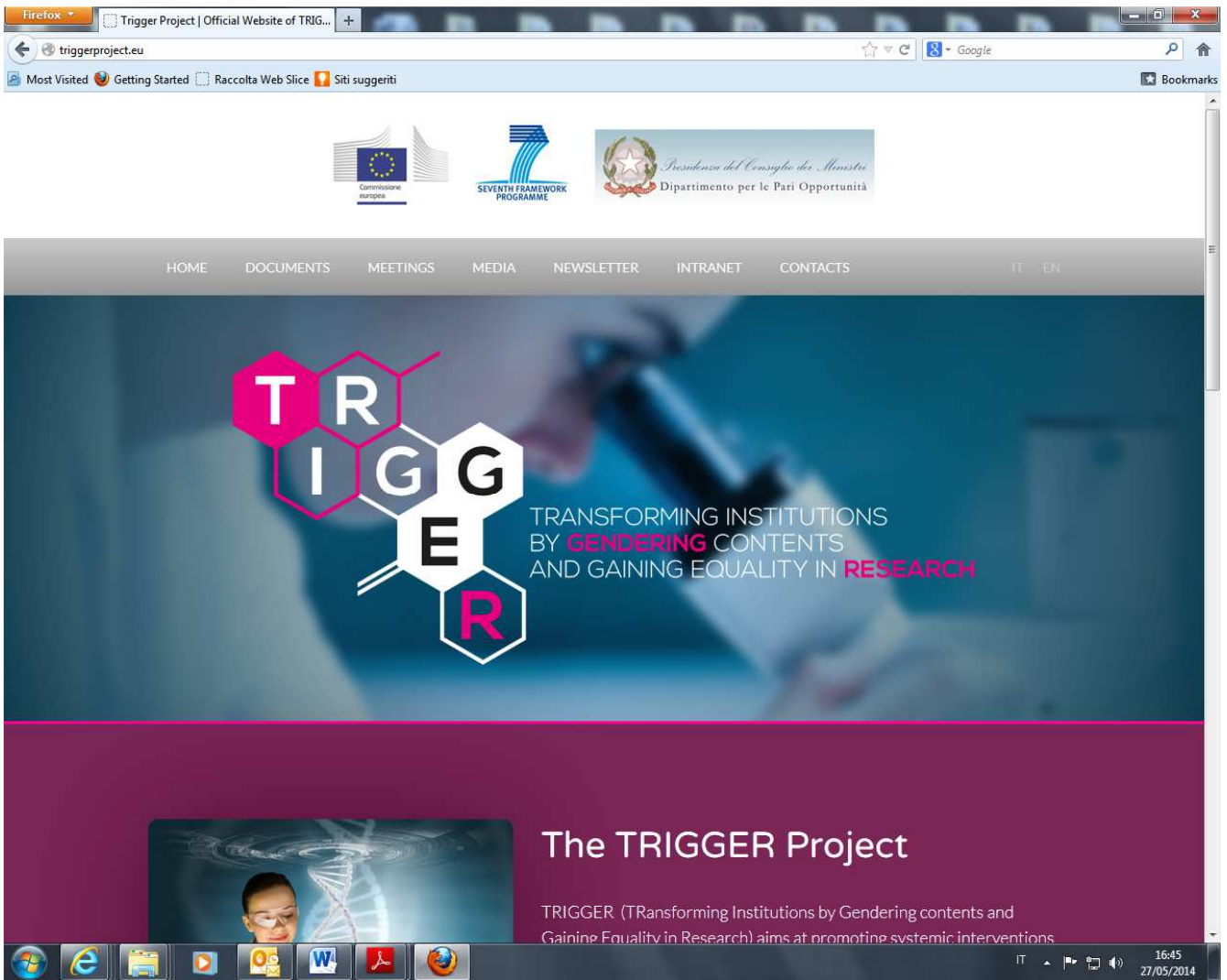

The web-site has been created in order to guarantee the following functions:

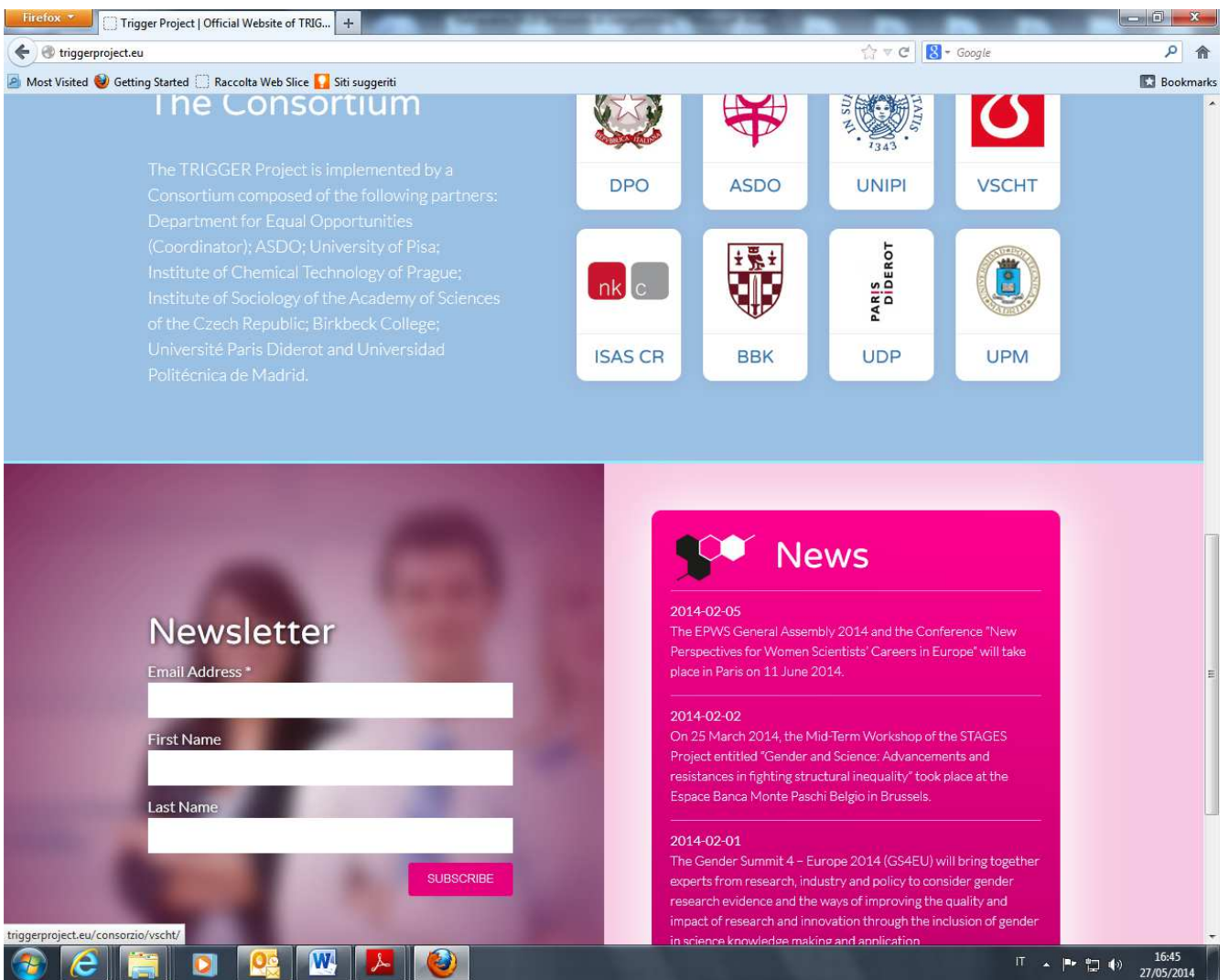
- information on TRIGGER activities and partners;

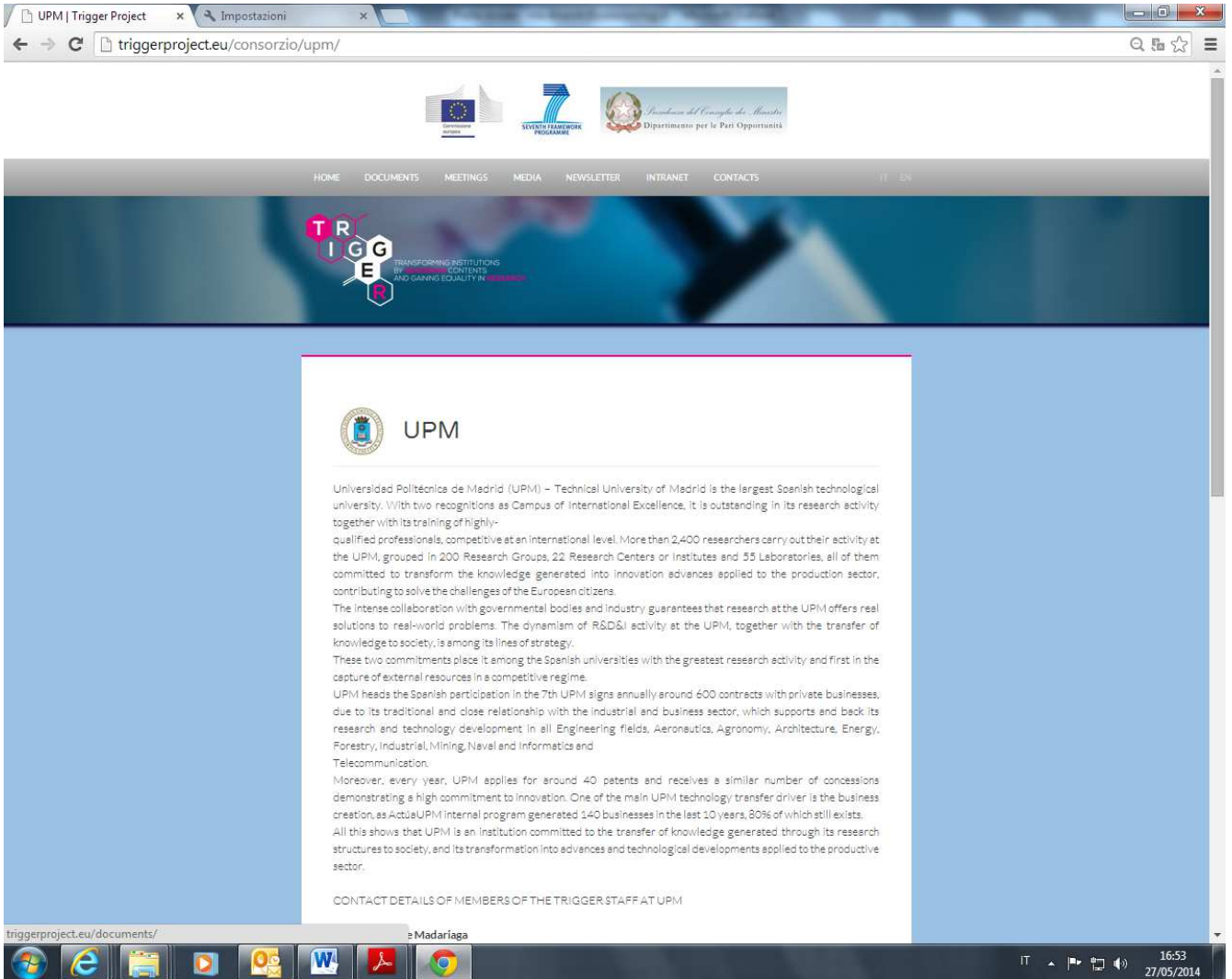

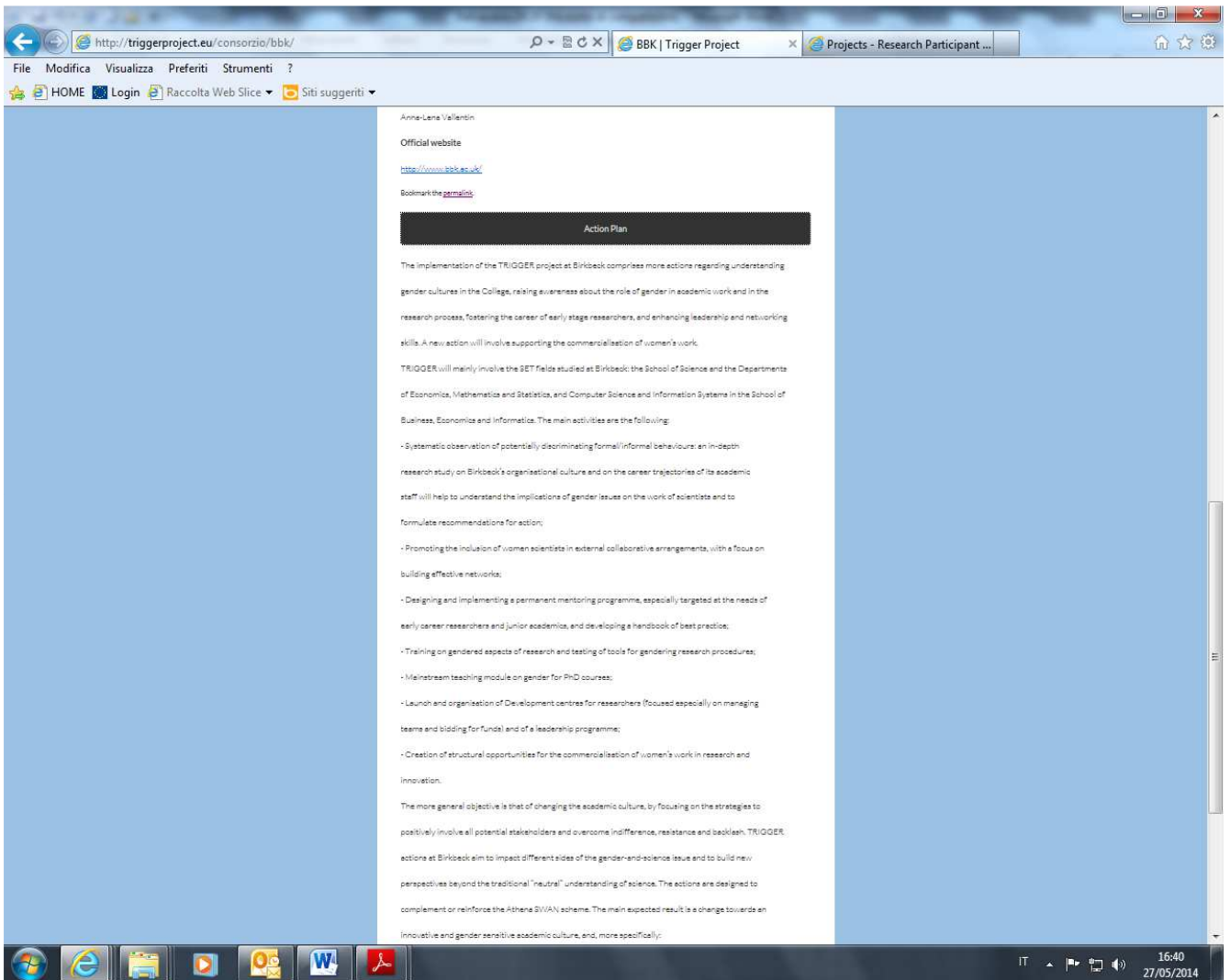


The web-site contains a specific section devoted to all the partners of the consortium (Picture n° 3) and their Action Plan (Picture n° 4).

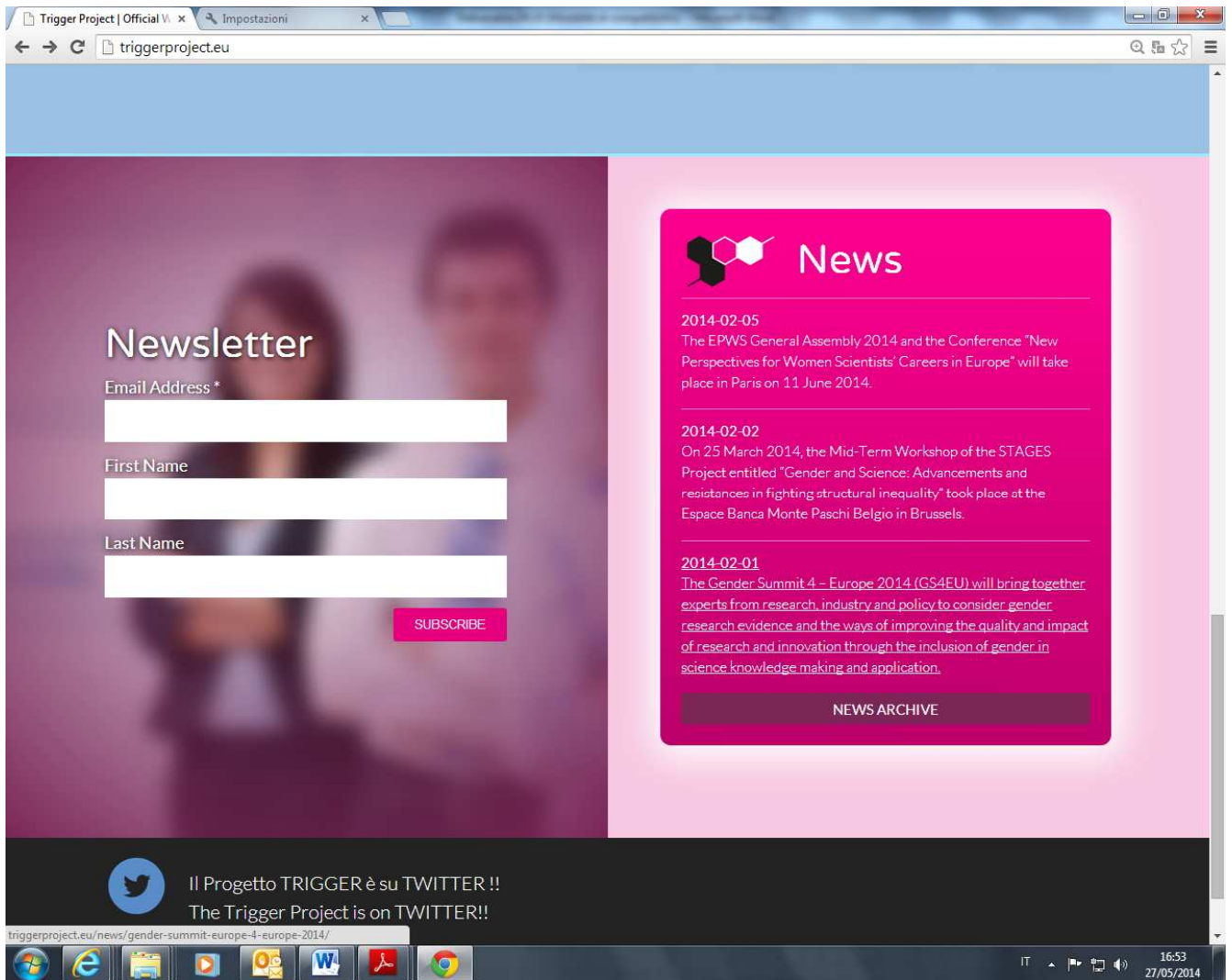
